Please fill out this questionnaire and return via email to barb@joyfulpaws.com or our fax at 920.876.3040. **There is no guarantee that by filling out this questionnaire that we can provide funds for a wheelchair, but we will certainly see how we can best help.**

We are not a non-profit, therefore donations are received as others hear about the work we do, so funds can be low or depleted at times- it just all depends. But again, if we can help, we will try our best to do that.

IMPORTANT: Along with this completed form you must also send verification from your vet on diagnoses and prognosis.

Also, this is **first come, first serve**. So if we have some funds available, as well as the order in which we receive requests, is how we base this and who we can help, along with answers to your questions below.

How old is your dog? What is his or her name?

What is the breed?

What is the diagnosis?

If diagnosis is IVDD what do you know about this disease?

What treatment have you done? Is he/she on a current treatment plan?

What is prognosis?

If this is IVDD when did your dog go down (when did you notice something was wrong?) When did he/she see vet?

Did you do surgery or conservative treatment?

If conservative treatment, how long have you been doing?

If you opted for surgery, when was the surgery?

Does your dog have bladder and bowel control?

If your dog has been diagnosed with IVDD, do you know about www.dodgerslist.com?

If so, have you reached out to them for help? If so, please explain what they have advised you to do.

Please explain your reason for contacting us in regards to a wheelchair? What is your financial situation? We ask that you are honest in sharing this information.

What can you contribute toward the wheelchair? We ask for your complete honesty with this question. The funds can be limited at times, so we ask that whatever you can pay toward the wheelchair so that the fund can help as many pets as we can.

Have you checked into the cost of a wheelchair? If so, where and what cost have you been given?

Lastly, should your dog walk again after getting a wheelchair (or when they pass away) we require that the wheelchair be donated back to Eddie's wheels so that it can help another pet.

We also ask that should we be able to help your dog with a wheelchair that your provide us with a photo of your dog in their wheelchair so we can share on our website and Facebook so our donors are kept up to date on pets we have helped.
